<u>Presentation - Phil Corman gave an excellent overview of Mountain Flying. Taken from a larger presentation it was an abbreviated version but was nonetheless very comprehensive. Terrain features to use and those to avoid, canyons and flying on one side or the other as well as the right time of day to make the crossing were all discussed. As expected density altitude plays a big part, especially in landing and take off. Among the discussion items was staying in glide distance of roads if at all possible. Too much data to cover here but a copy of the slides are to be sent out in the next newsletterc.</u>

New Business


- Possibly a trip to New Cuyama was discussed. The idea to hold a Saturday meeting, get some flying in and see some aerobatics.


