Editors Message

I am continually disturbed by the poor reporting done by the media regarding airplane accidents. Here is a clipping of an accident.

But the essence of the article is valid for builders and pilots of homebuilt aircraft. The accident rate for homebuilts is higher than for production singles. I don't know the reason. It might be that the design was flawed or the build was flawed. Or it might be that the pilot put the plane under too much load. Who knows.



The problem is, according to Scott Stewart "The accident plane was NOT AN RV! Although it looked like an RV-6, it was not built from a Van's RV-6 kit. It was not an approved Van's RV-6 design. Don't judge the Van's RV design based on this accident. I've flown my RV-7 up to about 5.2 G's and feel completely safe regarding the structural engineering."

But this is what we do know. It is the PIC's responsibility to ensure that the airplane is airworthy and that it is flown "safely". Builders have a more intimate understanding of their aircraft. This should help.

Be safe out there. Winter flying affords some wonderful flying, but it also contains more storms, icing, and turbulence.

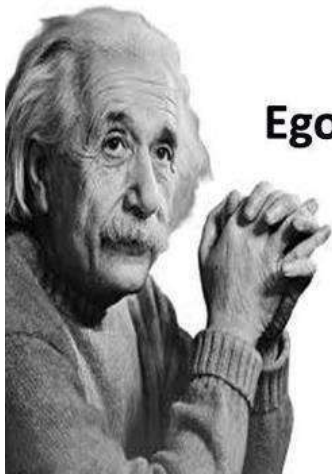
