President's Message

EAA members and guests are cordially invited to participate in the monthly meeting of the reenergized Paso Robles Chapter of the Experimental Aircraft Association. The meeting will occur on Wednesday February 11, 7:00 PM at the Airport Terminal. We will be discussing details for implementation of an interesting and challenging schedule of activities for 2015 (see following outline). *The keynote technical presentation, by Phil Corman, will be on ADS –B: What is it, what you need to know, who needs to have it in their planes, and when?*

During the past month there have been two initiatives to revitalize EAA Chapter 465. First, the Chapter had a brainstorming session on January 15, with 19 existing and new members attending. Second, the executive committee and team leaders followed up with a meeting on January 20. The objective of these meetings was to identify how to address the overall EAA mission, and our Chapters unique capabilities and interests. The following are key outcomes of these two initiatives.

- **Activities will reflect the overall EAA vision and mission.** EAA is a community of passionate aviation enthusiasts that promotes and supports recreational flying. Our vision is a vibrant and growing aviation community. Our mission is to grow participation in aviation by promoting the "Spirit of Aviation.". We serve the community by inspiring new participants in aviation, inviting the public to experience flight, providing a compelling view of possibilities, nurturing interest in aviation, supporting clear pathways to participation.

- **We have an initial schedule of activities for 2015 (see attached chart):** We agreed to change the meeting to the second Wednesday of each month, each meeting will include a short business meeting plus a technical presentation based on the interest of members. The schedule helps our members plan their participation in advance of these meetings and events.
- **We agreed to restart the young eagles program:** The first event is planned during airport appreciation day June 6. An experienced person, Frances Bowman, has offered to coordinate the events, and several other members have volunteered to assist.
- **We agreed to start a “member build/restore a plane” activity.** Mike Laubach offered to lead this activity; several other members have volunteered to assist. A member has offered a physical structure where the build program can be done. We are now actively looking locally and nationally for a donation of an experimental, or GA aircraft, to build or restore.
- **Promotion of the EAA mission in North County:** We agreed to more involved in promoting the goal of EAA in a variety of community activities, some of these may require additional funds. Phil Corman, the current Newsletter and Web Site coordinator agreed to lead these activities, and several members have also volunteered to assist.
- **Type Club Fly INS:** this activity can promote EAA and aviation in Paso, help draw in new EAA members, and support economic development in the N. County. It was agreed that we would investigate the possibility of getting one or two clubs to have a west coast fly-ins to Paso Robles. Dave Fretwell and Darrell Radford agreed

to take leadership for making contacts with Lancair and Cessna 172 clubs respectively.

- **Cooperation and Support with other Aviation organizations:** We agreed to more actively cooperate with, and support, when appropriate, the implementation of aviation related programs initiated with Estrella and the Paso Robles Airport Association (PRAA). Examples included the Estrella Warbirds event in August, supporting PRAA as it works with the Town in the implementation of the Airport Improvement Plan.

In summary, we are planning an aggressive Chapter program in 2015. This program must and will respond to the interests of members. The program can only be accomplished if individual members ‘step up to the plate’ and tell us what they want, and volunteer to help implement these activities.
