Plan ahead, the frustration of being held hostage by the FAA over health issues is not worth the gamble. It took me almost four years to get my medical back and then only with the help of AOPA, legal and medical teams. Now I am a sport pilot.

The sport pilot license has some minor restriction issues but really you can fly anywhere in the USA at altitude 10k and lower or 2K over any terrain. Now in 2012, I'm sure you've read, EAA and AOPA are submitting a request to the FAA for an exemption that would allow many pilots flying the


