Editors Message

The General Aviation Pilot Protection Act of 2013



Reps. Todd Rokita (R-Ind.) and Sam Graves (R-Mo.) have introduced a bill in the U.S. House that seeks to abolish the third-class medical certificate for many pilots who fly recreationally. The proposed rule would allow

pilots to use a valid state driver's license in place of the traditional medical certificate if the flights are:

- Not for compensation
- Conducted in VFR operations only, at or below 14,000ft MSL
- No faster than 250 knots
- In aircraft with no more than six seats and no more than 6,000 pounds' gross takeoff weight.

If you are like me, I dread the FAA Medical because I am older and more prone to things the FAA deems unsafe. And I also think the government allows people to drive vehicles much heavier than our airplanes without anything but a drivers license. I also think that most pilots I know are responsible and would probably self-ground themselves if any medical conditions threatened the safety of flight.
