7:00 PM, EAA Chapter 465 Wed. June 13

Meeting Called to Order – Meeting called to order at 7:10 by David Fretwell

Attendance – 10 members were in attendance

Treasurer Report - Dale gave the total as \$2,800. The Young eagle event cost \$300.00 and we received \$30.00 in donations in return.

Old Business

Young Eagles Gathering – approximately 35 people attended with parents. A couple of 16-18 year olds were there as well. It was discussed that the older age kids were probably the best targets to encourage

an interest in aviation. Joel made a presentation on the mechanics of aircraft and Elliot held a discussion

about the career of being a pilot. It was determined that the next opportunity to hold a similar event would be within a few months of the Airfest event. In this way we could leverage off of the interest created by having flown so recently.

T-Craft Fly-in – Dave and Jonnie went to a fly-in recently and met with the pilots. There was an overall interest in attending a Fly-in at Paso. The target date would be September 23-24. Dave will be arranging dinner at Eberle, a speaker or two and then a presentation the following day with a trip to Sculptura and

New Business

Airfest 2017 – the Saturday August 26th. Meetings have started and will be held the 2nd and 4th Tuesday's

of the month. We need as much help from folks as we can get. Anyone looking to be involved please contact Steve Allen. 674-6608. Young Eagle flights will be part of the event again and hosted in the same spot. The emphasis this year will be for fly-in traffic and invites are being sent out to about 160 type clubs to start with.

Some discussion was held about flying a pattern to increase the safety factor with the number of planes in the air but this was not a popular view. It was felt that as long as entry and exit from the pattern was consistent that no further requirements placed upon the pilots should be made. An invitation was extended to Dave Fretwell to discuss this at the next Airfest meeting.

Young Eagles Flights – some concern about the number of planes and the need for a central person to coordinate the event was raised. Bill Siegel has had to withdraw from his role as YE Coordinator and Dale Ramey agreed to take on the role and effort will be made to Doug Erway provide an aircraft.

Cal Pilots – they did not want to attend the Airfest event and will stick with their meeting plans in October. Phil is coordinating and the meeting will take place in Tina Leatherwood's hanger.

Chapter Elections – the positions of Secretary and Treasurer are coming up in November.

Lancair Fly-in –Western Region – this is planned for 2018 in Paso. Details as we get closer.

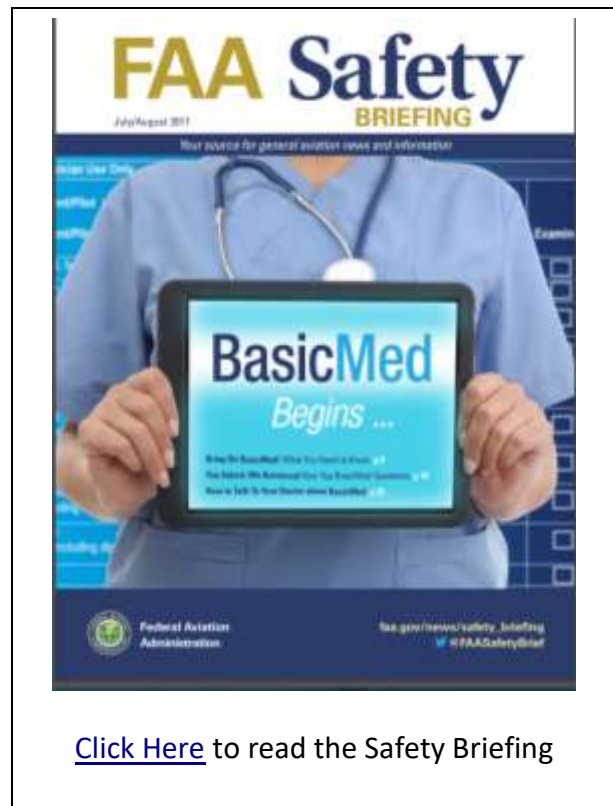

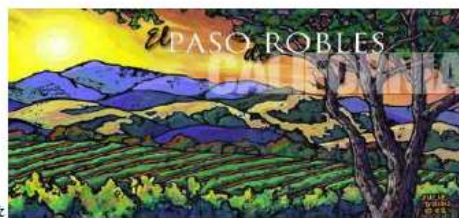

Saturday August 26, 2017 at 9:00 AM -3:00 PM**



- Have you ever wondered what your neighborhood looks like from the sky? Or maybe you're curious how airplanes even work. You might even dream about being a pilot. If you're nodding your head "Yes" and are between the ages of 8 and 17 you can take a free Young Eagles flight & see what pilots do on the ground & in the air.
- Since 1992, more than 2 million Young Eagles have enjoyed a flight from EAA's network of volunteer pilots. For many, it was the start of their journey to becoming a pilot, aircraft mechanic, air traffic controller, or many other aviation career possibilities.
- On Saturday Aug. 26, 2017, members of EAA Chapter 465 of Paso Robles will provide free flights to introduce young people to aviation at the Paso Robles Airport. Flights will originate from the vicinity of the airport terminal, commencing at approximately 9 to 10 am, weather permitting. A parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a permission form prior to the flight.
- After the flight, the Young Eagle will get a signed personal logbook and free access to Sporty's Learn to Fly Course (\$199 value), first flight lesson (\$120 value), admission to 300+ science and technology museums, Academy of Model Aeronautics Student Membership, electronic copy of *EAA Sport Aviation* monthly magazine, and access to valuable flight training awards, education scholarships, and Air Academy camperships.
