The PRAA is moving forward developing a proposal to the City for the **Paso Robles Municipal Airport Business Plan**. This has been worked on by the Airport Advisory Committee, since 2008, and then

suspended last year. The PRAA hopes to pickup that work and complete the Business Plan, which was identified in the 2003 Airport Master Plan, as a follow-on document. Stay tuned for our progress. We submitted our 3-page proposal to the City on May 18 and requested a decision by the City within 7 days. We got a response from Jim App, City Manager, that staff was busy and could not review our 3-page proposal in 7 days. No estimated date was given. The document was also sent to Roger Oxborrow and Meg Williamson who declined to comment.

The Estrella Warbird Museum is planning an air show here at Paso Robles on Saturday, September 29th. The Planes of Fame Museum down in Chino will be providing approximately 14 planes for the show. In speaking with Sherman Smoot, the organizer, he hopes to have triple that number of planes in 2013 and make it the premier air show event on the Central Coast. The PRAA has stepped up and offered to support this effort with manpower.
