The Airport Business Improvement Plan passed the next phase by being approved by the Airport Advisory Committee at the August 22 meeting by 4-1 vote. The next step includes a few minor edits to the Plan, followed by the vote by City Council, date to be determined soon. We are one step closer to having this document approved and begin executing on this document.

Airport Road Cleanup


The PRAA continues to make work hard on behalf of the airport. This past month we had 20 volunteers cleaning Airport Road from Highway 46 all the way to Tower Road. A special thanks to Pete Johnson for going back a week later and completing the work from the Airport to Tower Road since the cleanup crew didn't work that section. All told, we filled 19 large bags with roadside trash.

New Fuel Depot

The new Fuel Depot was approved by City Council. We are happy to report that your PRAA worked hard with the City and with the Jet Center to have the location placed in what we consider to be the Optimal location, just south of the old Gas House. Additionally the City will provide multiple plane access to the fuel pump, not included in Roger's original proposal. This was sought after for safety and convenience. A huge thank you to the City for such a great process and final decision. Airport Cleanup

The PRAA is still working hard to restart the Airport Advisory Committee's "Airport Cleanup" effort. We have been told there are plans in place to address the rest of the more than 1300 acres, and have provided manpower to assist in the cleanup of each parcel. We ask that the Master Lease holders take responsibility. We will see what happens.


