Meeting Minutes July 13, 2016

Meeting Called to Order – Meeting called to order at 7:06 PM

Attendance – 8 members were in attendance 3 guests

Old Business

Approval of Meeting Minutes - Darrel Radford moved to approved last meeting minutes and Mac Gleim was the second.

Treasurer Report - \$3,021.71 is in the bank. Mac motioned to accept, Ralph was second.

Member Count – currently there are 68 people in the Chapter including students.

Airfest (Airport Appreciation Day) October 1, 2016 - Steve Allen indicated that the project is progressing. Nothing new to report. Just in the middle period where there is a great deal to work going on but no major items to discuss. Dave wants to see a one page on the program.

Bill discussed Young Eagles – so far not many pilots so is it possible that it may need to be cancelled (update 8/3 we now have a core of volunteers) If there are more planes and pilots. A decision point would be by August 9th as far as going forward with the advertising. Passed around a sign in sheet, they are looking for 5 to 7 pilots/planes .

2017 AOPA West Coast – Phil wasn't in attendance so no update. No final word on if Paso will be the location. We are in competition with Camarillo.

2016 Mooney Fly-in – Phil was not here but the fly-in is planned for mid September.

Update on Restoration of Taylorcraft

Bill discussed that they have been gluing and ironing fabric and are now down to the last control surfaces. The next up is the envelope for the fuselage. The wings have been signed off.

Lancair National Fly-in 2017

Dave has not heard yet but there is a great deal of support so he feels there is a good chance to get it. However, they are competing with Las Vegas.

ADSB – Dave discussed a rebate program upcoming for \$500.00 for early installation. Limited number of them available. Worth looking into, see details on the FAA web-site.

Paso Robles, CA, July 26, 2016: AirFest 2016 will take place on Friday, Sept. 30 and Saturday, Oct. 1 at Paso Robles Municipal Airport located at 4912 Wing Way. The two-day event will feature aircraft displays, activities, and entertainment for the entire family and aircraft aficionados of all ages.

The AirFest kicks off with "The Party," on Friday, Sept. 30, 5pm-10pm in The Hangar with tours, live music, food, wine and beer.

"Run the Runways," will be held on Saturday, Oct. 1, 8am - 9am and includes: 10k, 5k, and beginner categories for youth, military, and senior participation in a special "Run the Runways" event. A Pancake Breakfast will follow "Run the Runways" from 9am-11am near the Airport Terminal Building. Breakfast is free for participants and \$10 for non-participants.

Enjoy aerial demonstrations by the Cloud Clippers, a Kid Zone, and BBQ lunch. Tour the Airport and talk with pilots about their aircraft. Free airplane rides for ages 8-17 provided by the Young Eagles, sponsored by EAA Chapter 465, led by David Fretwell.

Eagles Program will take flight in Paso Robles**
Saturday Oct 1, 2016 at 9:00 am



- Have you ever wondered what your neighborhood looks like from the sky? Or maybe you're curious how airplanes even work. You might even dream about being a pilot. If you're nodding your head "Yes" and are between the ages of 8 and 17, you're ready to take a free Young Eagles flight and see what real pilots do on the ground and in the air.
- Since 1992, more than 2 million Young Eagles have enjoyed a flight from EAA's network of volunteer pilots. For many, it was the start of their journey to becoming a pilot, aircraft mechanic, air traffic controller, or many other aviation career possibilities.
- On Saturday Oct. 1, 2016, members of EAA Chapter 465 of Paso Robles will provide free flights to introduce young people to aviation at the Paso Robles Airport. Flights will originate from the vicinity of the airport terminal, commencing at approximately 9 to 10 am, weather permitting. A parent or legal guardian will be required to sign a permission form prior to the flight.
- After the flight, the Young Eagle will get a signed personal logbook and free access to Sporty's Learn to Fly Course (\$199 value), first flight lesson (\$120 value), admission to 300+ science and technology museums, Academy of Model Aeronautics Student Membership, electronic copy of *EAA Sport Aviation* monthly magazine, and access to valuable flight training awards, education scholarships, and Air Academy camperships.
