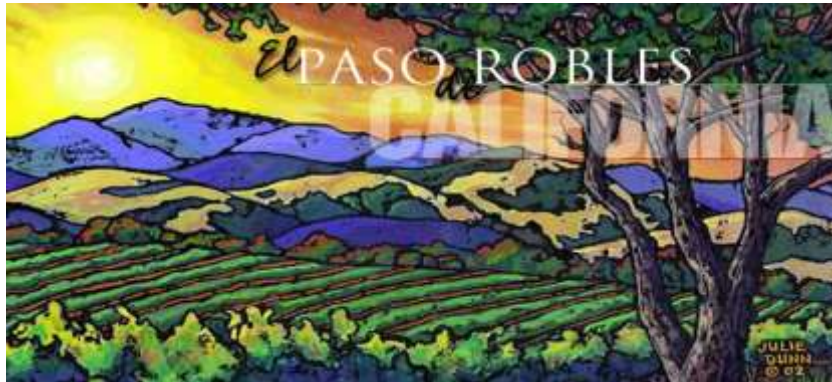


# TAYLORCRAFT WEST COAST GATHERING

**Organizer/Host<sup>3</sup>:** The host will be the Paso Robles EAA Chapter 465 [www.eaa465.org](http://www.eaa465.org). The Chapter is working with Taylorcraft owners, Antique Aero and the Estrella Warbirds Museum [www.ewarbirds.org](http://www.ewarbirds.org), City/Airport of Paso Robles [www.prcity.com](http://www.prcity.com) to plan the event. *Chapter 465 is restoring a 1940 Taylorcraft.*

**Transport and Accommodation:** Transport to all event venues downtown hotels, will be available from the Host EAA Chapter. Participants who arrive on Friday and/or wish to stay and explore the area on Sunday may want to rent a vehicle with Enterprise at the Airport 805-239-0628 & UBER is available. Aircraft fuel discount will be available, overnight airplane parking fees waived and camping permitted on the airport. Transport to Saturday afternoon/evening winery events planned by classic and antique cars. **If you are staying in a hotel book early (i.e. two months ahead if possible) as this is busy tourist season [www.booking.com](http://www.booking.com) suggested.**

**Cost:** \$37 per person including breakfast & lunch, and Aircraft museum tours on Sept 23, or \$77 including previous items, plus 2 winery visits (Eberly and Sculpterra), visit to the Paso Robles Pioneer Museum, and dinner at the Paso Robles Inn Winery PM 23rd.
