

YOUNG EAGLES AND PARENTS SPECIAL FOLLOW-UP EVENT NOVEMBER 4, 2017

The objective of the free breakfast event on Saturday Nov. 4 is to provide Young Eagles and their parents, with more information about aviation, related careers, & recreational use of aircraft. The event is being organized by the Paso Chapter 465 of the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA)

After their flight on August 26 each Young Eagle gets a signed personal logbook & a personal identification number (**do not lose your log book**) which gives each young eagle the following benefits:

- National membership in EAA. **Watch for an Electronic Mail (EM) from EAA in the coming weeks,**
- Membership in Paso Experimental Aircraft Chapter 465 & a **monthly EM Newsletter from EAA465,**
- Electronic copies of the EAA Sport Aviation monthly magazine. **Watch for these electronic magazines,**
- Free Access to Sporty's Pilot Shop "Learn to Fly" Course (\$199 value). Each YE will get an EM from Sporty's with a name & password to access the Course, **Watch for an EM from Sporty's pilot shop in the coming weeks.**
- A first flight lesson (\$120 value) after completing several chapters of the Sporty "learn to fly course"
- Admission to 300+ science and technology museums,
- Student Membership in the Academy of Model Aeronautics,
- Access to valuable flight training awards, education scholarships, and Air Academy camperships.



The Nov. 3 free pancake breakfast for young eagles and parents will be held at the Paso Robles Airport, from 8:30 to 11:00 AM on Saturday Nov. 4 th and will include a:

- Review of EAA Young Eagles benefits, including demonstration of the free ground school and details of how to get the free flying lesson through Sporty's Pilot Shop.
- Presentations and discussions on aviation careers, and aviation as a recreational activity
- Viewing of a range of General Aviation aircraft ,
